Minor Puppy 4, 2a

1st Metcalfe's Baileydale Rocket Man, yellow 7 months. I was really taken by this promising young dog. Super head with a melting expression.
Excellent front assembly. Balanced throughout.
Excellent movement, handled at just the right speed.
I will watch this boy with interest. I couldn't overlook the quality and even at his young age delighted to award him Best Dog and then Best Puppy In Show, also Best Opposite Sex.

2<sup>nd</sup> Walton's Gallybob Uno, Nicley made puppy with good overall shape and proportions. Rather full of it which made accessing movement rather challenging.

Junior Dog 3, 1a

Both quality chocolate boys but at different stages.

2<sup>nd</sup> Venturi-Rose's Sagacity's Midnight Music at Leospring. Finer than 1, but in proportion and correctly made. Needed to settle on the move to get the best from him.

1<sup>st</sup> Wiles's Richbourne Lion King, yellow puppy. Beautifully made. Good head. Moved better in this class than the earlier ones. Correct front and rear assembly. Good length of leg.

2<sup>nd</sup> Kerr's Trulace Ambassador. Super colour and pigment. Would like to see a longer length of stride, perhaps not striding out as well in this indoor ring.

## Graduate Dog 2, 0a

1<sup>st</sup> Bambrook's Winsleywood Waghorn at Ravoakar JW. I have previously judged this boy as a puppy, I liked him then and I still like him now. Balanced throughout, super shape. Attractive head with nice expression. Great neat feet, tight and good shape. I'd just like a bit more of him in size. This boy is always shown in super condition and the handler gets the best from him.

2<sup>nd</sup> Gentleman's Wynfaul Repeat. Good looking dog who I was quite taken with. Pleased with his overall size and shape. Good reach of neck, level topline, but movement massively let him down. Change of handler did help a bit but he needs to settle and get on with the job in hand.

1<sup>st</sup> Boulden's Rumhill Firecracker JW. Good substance throughout. Masculine head with nice expression. Strong neck, good assembly front and rear, straight legs. Level topline. Moved well. Awarded Reserve Best Dog.

2<sup>nd</sup> Jenner's Lyjansen Simba's Savanna. Lovely kind expression. Good front, strong hindquarters. Moved ok. Got on with the job but lacked the spark today.

3<sup>rd</sup> Sadler's Talifen Gentleman Jack

Limit Dog 2, 0a

1<sup>st</sup> Mount's Buckholt Desert Storm Duke. Pleasing shape, with everything in proportion. Good front into well laid shoulders. Beautifully handled.

2<sup>nd</sup> Tipson's Ffurador First Past The Post. Looked heavy over shoulders, felt he was carrying too much weight which spoilt movement.

1<sup>st</sup> Autey's Chadfirth Alcazaba. Super masculine head with lovely kind expression. Good depth to body. Good angulation front and rear. Powerful well muscled hindquarters. Moved well with drive. Best Veteran In Show.



Special Beginners Dog 4, 2a

1<sup>st</sup> Kerr's Trulace Ambassador, 2<sup>nd</sup> in maiden.

2<sup>nd</sup> Tipson's Ffurador First Past The Post, 2<sup>nd</sup> in limit.

Special Veteran 7-9 Dog or Bitch 4, 1a

1<sup>st</sup> Autey's Chadfrith Alcazaba, 1<sup>st</sup> open dog.
